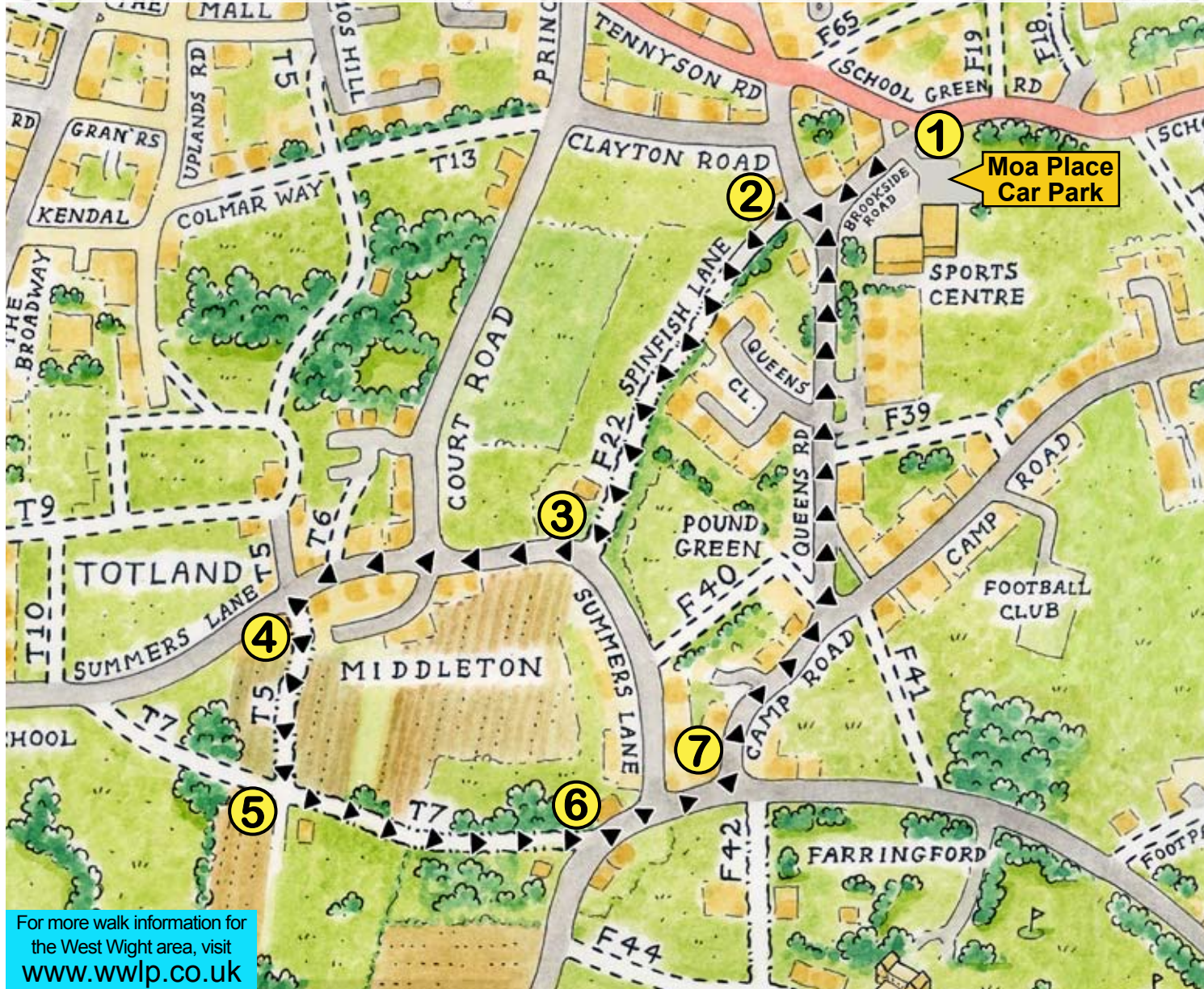


# Buggy Walks in West Wight

All walks start from Moa Place Car Park



**MIDDLETON** · About 1 1/2 miles/2.4km long. Takes about 45 minutes to 1 hour. On pavements, some roads without pavements, and footpaths, which can get a bit muddy

- ① Turn left out of Moa Place Car Park, and down Brookside Road under the conker trees.
- ② Cross Queens Road to join Spinfish Lane (F22). Follow this as it leads beside the stream.
- ③ When Spinfish Lane joins Summers Lane, turn right and walk up the lane, taking care as there are no pavements.
- ④ Turn left at bridleyway T5, where the track is unmade. Follow the track to Stone Wind Farm.
- ⑤ At the junction with T7, turn left and follow this down to Bedbury Lane.
- ⑥ Walk down Bedbury Lane, taking care as there are no pavements.  
*Alternatively, you could take the quieter Summers Lane on your left and retrace your steps back via Spinfish Lane.*
- ⑦ Turn left down Camp Road and follow this, then Queens Road, back to Moa Place Car Park.
