1 Sheep were dipped at Sheepwash Farm where the stream could be dammed.

Q Why were sheep dipped in the stream?



2 Can you find where this photo was taken? It may look very different at other times of year.



3 This tree is known locally as an 'Apse Pipple' and this is the only mature grove of them on the Isle of Wight.

Q Do you know what type of tree this is? Can you find where the grove of trees is?

1. Sheep were dipped to give them a wash and get rid of bugs in their fleeces.
2. This is on bridleway T7 looking north towards Summers Lane.
3. This is aspen. If you listen carefully, you may hear the quivering sound of the wind in their leaves. Another local name for them is 'Snapsen'.
