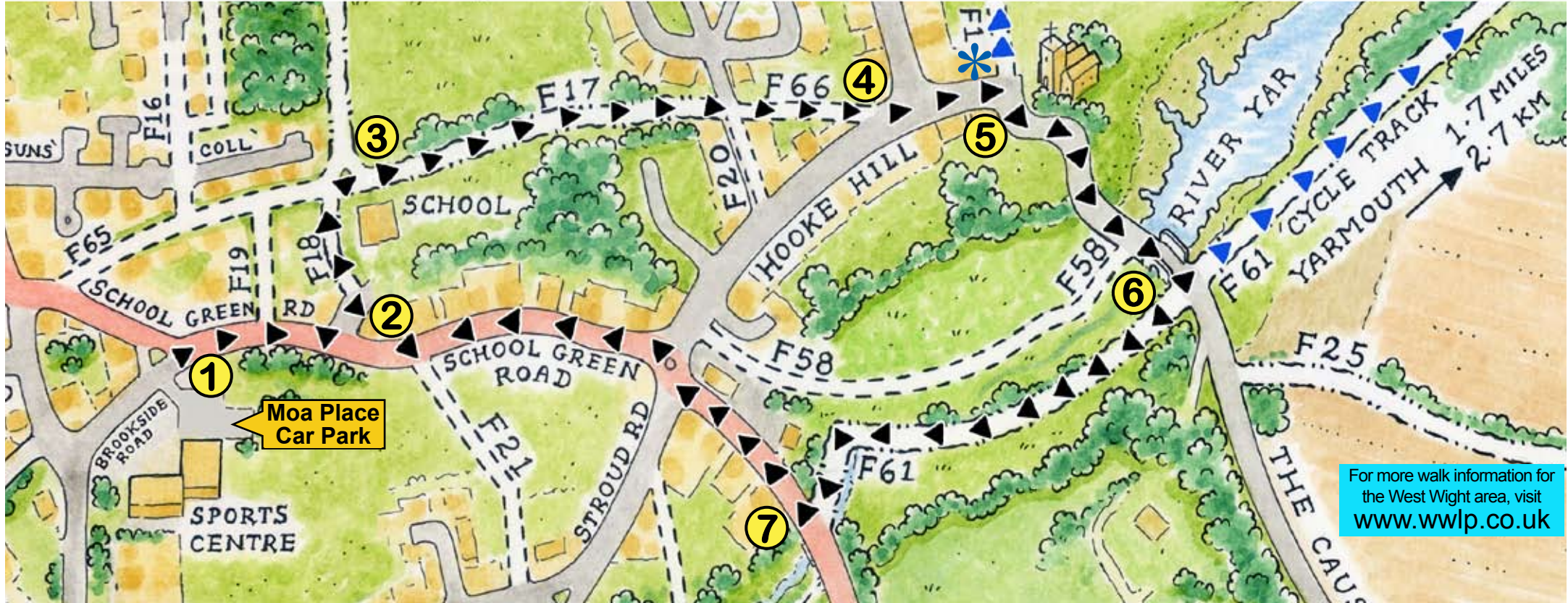


Buggy Walks in West Wight

All walks start from Moa Place Car Park

THE CAUSEWAY · About 1 mile/1.6km long. Takes about 30 to 40 minutes.



- ① Turn right out of Moa Place Car Park, onto School Green Road.
- ② Turn left up path F18 beside the school
- ③ Turn right along F17, Longhalves Lane, and follow this until it comes out on Hookes Hill.
- ④ Cross over to Church Place, walking past the Red Lion pub, in front of the church. *
- ⑤ Go down the hill, taking care as there are no pavements

* Here you could make this a long walk by taking path F1 between the pub and the church. This is accessible by buggy and leads to Yarmouth. You come back from Yarmouth on the other side of the river on the F61 cycle track—just under 4 miles.

- ⑥ Turn right onto the cycletrack F62 which brings you out next to the Garden Centre.
- ⑦ Turn right, past the Co-Op, and back along School Green Road to Moa Place Car Park.

These walks have been based on the 'West Wight Pushchair Walks' published by the Isle of Wight NHS Primary Care Trust, and the Isle of Wight Council. They have been tested by parents from the West Wight Children's Centre and every effort has been made to ensure that they are suitable for families with buggies. However, they are not guaranteed to be suitable for everyone at all times and you are advised to be prepared for changes. Take care, and have fun!
