

# Buggy Walks in West Wight

All walks start from Moa Place Car Park



## FARRINGFORD

About 2 miles/3.2km long. Takes about 1 to 1 1/2 hours.

- 1 Turn left out of Moa Place Car Park, and down Brookside Road under the conker trees
- 2 Turn left on Queens Road and follow this all the way to Bedbury Lane—take care as there is no pavement in places.
- 3 Cross Bedbury Lane to join footpath F42 up a stony path that leads up to Farringford Farm
- 4 Footpath F44 goes off to your right, but you take F47 on the left, keeping the old stone farm walls to your left. Follow this path round the back of Farringford House until the path joins the road again.
- 5 Turn right and walk down the road in front of the old thatched church, then turn left down Blackbridge Road – take care as there are no pavements.
- 6 Turn left down Easton Lane and follow this until you come to Victoria Road.
- 7 Turn right and follow this through to Stroud Road.
- 8 Cross over Stroud Road and take footpath F21 on your left, across the playing fields, and back to Moa Place Car Park.
