Did you know... Summer's Lane used to be the main road between Freshwater and Totland!



1 Sharp eyes may spot this sign on some cottages in Clayton Road.

Q Can you guess what the Irex was?



Did you know... A 'tout' is a name for a look-out. So at 'Totland', there was a look-out to guard against pirates and marauders!

1. Irex Cottages were built using timbers from the Irex; a ship that was wrecked off Scratchell's Bay on January 26th 1890.
2. This is an oak tree. There are several along footpath T13.
3. This is at Sheepwash Farm at Spinifish Lane, Middleton.
